I am writing to inform you of the 2018 Infant Sports Day which will be held on Friday 22nd June starting at 1.30pm. It will be held on the field adjacent to the Infant car park.

This year, we have changed the Sports Day format which will allow all children to experience a range of differentiated activities working around a carousel. Each child will be competing and scoring points for their house and will participate with their class/group. We will have the traditional activities such as the egg and spoon and the sack race but also include more sport specific events as well as competitive races.

Unlike previous years where children wore their house colours, this year, please could all children wear the following if possible; pumps/trainers, white socks, navy blue shorts and a blue polo shirt. Please do not worry if you do not have these items, appropriate sportswear will be acceptable for Pre-School children.

We welcome all parents and family friends to this fantastic sporting showcase! As the children will be moving from event to event, may we ask parents to stay behind the roped area as a matter of health and safety. You also may wish to bring a chair to this event.

If the Sports Day is cancelled, due to adverse weather, the reserve date will be Tuesday 3rd July at 1.30pm. If Sports Day is cancelled on the reserve date, the Sports Day will be held at a later date, without spectators. If you are unsure if sports day will be on or off, please check the School website, Facebook and Twitter from 1pm.

However, if it is sunny on sports day it is advisable to send your child to School with a drink, sun cream and a navy blue sun hat.

At the end of sports day, please allow the children to return to their classes with their teachers and for parents to wait on the field until all classes have returned to School. Parents can then collect their child from the usual meeting place after the event,

Unfortunately, there is limited parking in the Infant car park. Please be aware that Traffic Wardens operate in this area.

The Parents Association will be providing an opportunity for the parents to purchase refreshments at this event.

The children are very much looking forward to their Sports Day activities and we look forward to welcoming you to the event.
