Dear Parents

I am writing to explain the arrangements for the next couple of months.

Your son will begin his study leave on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May at 12.15pm. This means that he will not need to attend school unless he has an examination. When he comes to school, he must sign in at the school office, and if he has an examination, he must hand his phone into the school office. If your son is caught with a mobile phone in the examination room, the School has an obligation to report it to the exam board for suspected mal practice, which will likely result in his examination result being cancelled. When he attends school, he must ensure that he is wearing full school uniform; he will not be allowed into the examination room unless he is correctly dressed.

As a farewell treat, we are having a 'Good Luck' breakfast in the Sixth Form Centre café on the morning of their final day. In addition, we have organised a trip to Alton Towers for the boys and girls on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June. If your son wishes to attend this trip then he must return a consent form as soon as possible.

On that day he will need to attend school at 8.30am and will need to return all of his text books and library books, plus pay any outstanding debts to the school office. Parents will receive an invoice for any books which are not returned to school on this day.

Results will be available for collection from the school between **9am and 10am on Thursday 22nd August**. Members of staff will be on hand to offer advice and support on this day and we very much welcome parents to accompany their sons on this important occasion.
