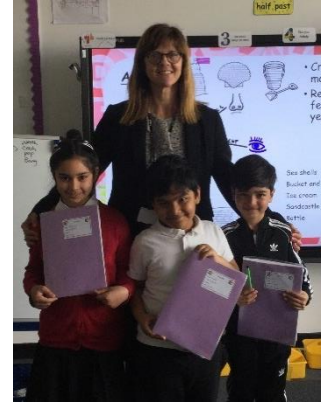
Easter Parade
