OUT OF THE ARK MUSIC

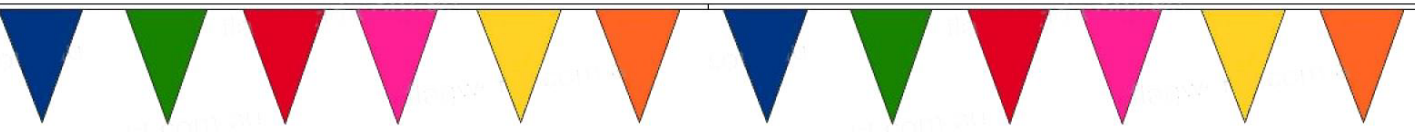


Out of the Ark have uploaded 5 weeks' worth of videos. You can sing, dance and complete other activities. There is a song for each day of the week.

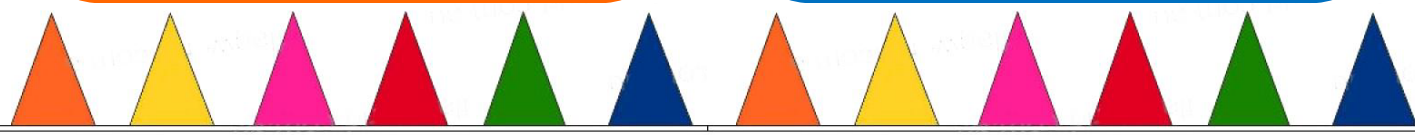
