Breakfast Club



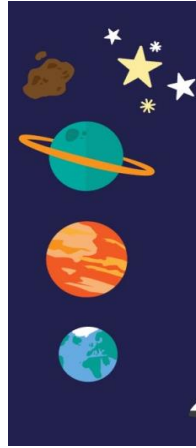
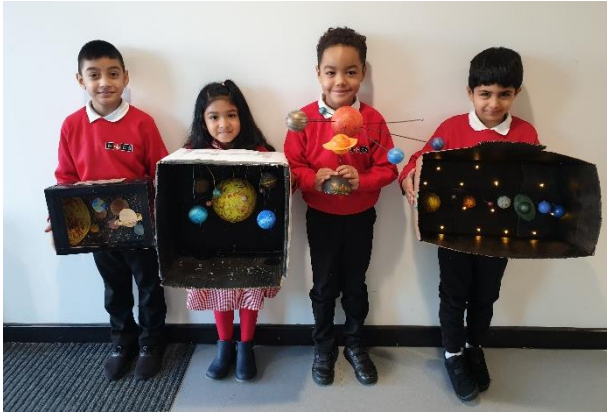
We are very proud of our ECS breakfast club which children love attending.
