

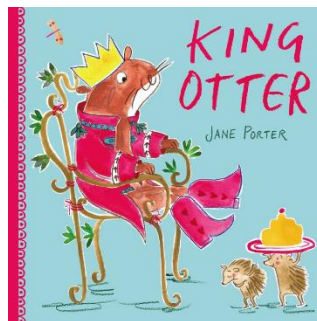


## Library Re-opening with Jane Porter
