### Normal Admissions Round – Year 6 into 7 – September 2019

Event	Dates	<i>What the Department for Education says in the 'School Admission Appeals Code - 1 February 2012' &amp; 'School Admissions Code – 19 December 2014'</i>
National notification day	Friday 1st March 2019	<i>for secondary school applications, all offers must be made on the same secondary National Offer Day i.e. 1 March or the next working day</i>
<b>Deadline for lodging an appeal with the Appeals Team at Bucks CC</b>	<b>Friday 29th March 2019</b>	<b><i>the deadline for lodging appeals allows appellants at least 20 school days from the date of notification that their application was unsuccessful to prepare and lodge their written appeal</i></b>
Appeal dates	Appeals will be heard in May/June 2019	<i>appeals must be heard within 40 school days of the deadline for lodging appeals appellants [must] receive at least 10 school days' notice of their appeal hearing</i>
Notification of decision	Within 5 school days of the hearing	<i>decision letters are sent within five school days of the hearing wherever possible</i>

Event	Dates	<i>What the Department for Education says in the 'School Admission Appeals Code - 1 February 2012' &amp; 'School Admissions Code – 19 December 2014'</i>
Deadline for lodging an appeal	Within 20 school days of being notified that an application was unsuccessful	<i>the deadline for lodging appeals allows appellants at least 20 school days from the date of notification that their application was unsuccessful to prepare and lodge their written appeal</i>
Appeal dates	Within 30 school days of appeal being lodged	<i>appeals must be heard within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged</i>
Notification of decision	Within 5 school days of the hearing	<i>decision letters are sent within five school days of the hearing wherever possible</i>

As Ousedale School is a dual campus school a place will be offered at the alternative campus, where the designated campus is at or over its Published Admission Number (PAN) and the alternative campus is under its PAN. Appeals cannot be heard for admission to a particular campus.
