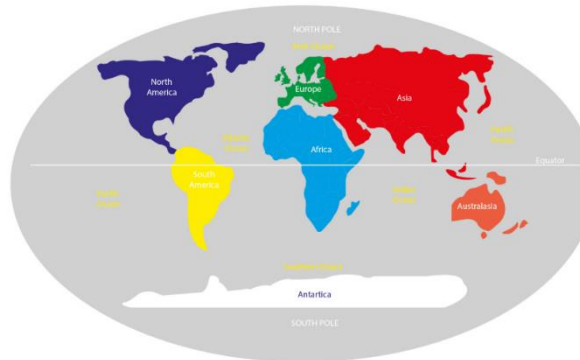

| Key Vocabulary | Definitions |
|----------------|---|
| Hemisphere | Half of the earth, usually as divided into northern and southern halves by the equator. |
| North Pole | The North Pole is the northern end of Earth's axis |
| South Pole | The South Pole is the Southern end of Earth's axis |
| Equator | An imaginary line which divides the Earth into the Northern and Southern hemispheres |
| Arctic | The region around the North pole. |
| Antarctic | The region around the South pole. |
| Igloo | A shelter made from blocks of snow. |
| Weather | What it is like outside - for example, sunny, raining, snowing. |
| Polar region | The areas around the North and South Poles. |

We will be learning about the Polar Regions. We will be learning about the weather conditions in the North and South Pole, the people and animals that live there and how to locate these areas on a map or globe.
