Atlas	A book of maps.

Capital city	Is a city or town, that usually serves as the location of the government's central meeting place and offices.
Continent	One of the main land masses of the Earth. There are 7 continents.
Equator	Imaginary line around the earth. At an equal distance between the North and South poles.
Habitat	A habitat is the home of an animal or a plant. Almost every place on Earth—from the hottest desert to the coldest ice pack—is a habitat for some kinds of animals and plants.
Inhabitant	A person or animal that live in a place.
Indigenous	Something that can be found or is from the place or country.
Landmark	Something (such a building, a large tree, or a statue) that is easy to see or has historical importance that can help a person find the way to a place near it.
