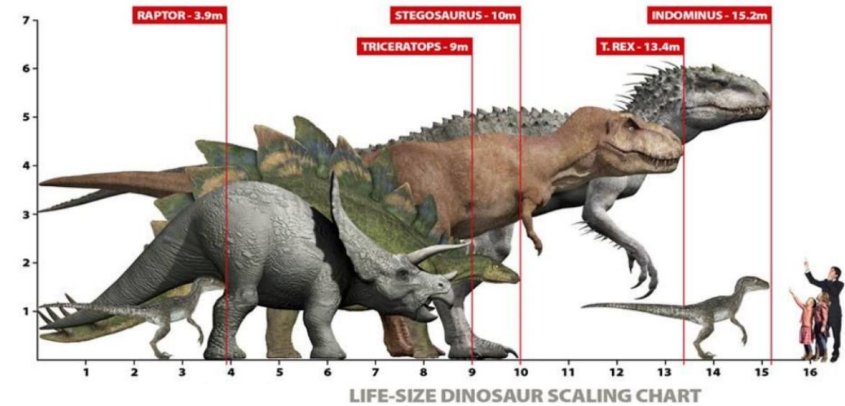

| Key Vocabulary | Definition |
|-----------------|--|
| Dinosaur | An extinct group of animals who were on Earth for more than 150 million years. The last kinds became extinct about sixty-five million years ago. |
| Extinct | Something that no longer exists. |
| Fossil | The remains or traces of plants and animals that lived long ago. |
| Herbivore | An animal that only feeds on plants. |
| Omnivore | An animal that feeds on plants and animals. |
| Carnivore | An animal that only feeds on other animals. |
| Vegetation | Plants or plant life in a particular place. |
| Pre-historic | Belonging to a period in a time before written history. |
| Palaeontologist | A scientist who studies ancient life, like the dinosaurs. |
