Setting	The setting is the time and place in which the story happens
Character	A person or animal in a story
Hero	The main character in a story. A hero is usually good and well-liked
Villain	The character who is the opposite of the hero. The villain could be mean, nasty or evil.
Plot	The events that make up the main part of the story
